Latin is a classical language offered as a major at Asbury. Studies include vocabulary and grammar, as well as the culture, literature, history and geography in which Latin originated. In addition, a student may also attain a teaching certificate ( $\mathrm{P}-12$ ) in Latin. Many students contemplating graduate work in linguistics or the professional schools of law, medicine or dentistry find the study of a classical language to be an advantageous undergraduate major.

To graduate must complete all major requirements, foundational requirements, and additional electives needed for 124 hour minimum degree requirement.
