ASBURY UNIVERSITY DEPARTMENT OF MUSIC Upperclassman Instrumental Study Advancement Form

1. As indicated in the *Music Department Handbook*, proficiency levels for music students will be reviewed by an extended jury examination at the end of the 4th semester of private study as a music major. A sophomore recital which demonstrates appropriate literature, and for which credit has been received (RCT 280) with a grade of B or better, may be accepted in lieu of a jury examination at the discretion of the jury examiners. All other private instrumental students wishing to enter upperclassman instrumental studies as a music major must perform a jury examination which includes appropriate literature, major and minor (3 forms) scales, and other technique deemed appropriate by the studio teacher.

If the student performs a selection on an Open Student Recital at the end of the semester, only the scale/technique portion will need to be performed during the jury exams. In this situation, the student may request that the jury comments and grade be given at *either* the recital *or* the jury examination (or both). The student may choose his/her preference for grading. If the choice is for the grade to be given at the jury examination and not at the recital, then both the jury form and this form should be brought to the jury. Otherwise, only this form will be needed at the time of instrumental juries. Your request to be advanced to the upperclass-level of instrumental studies (INS 411) will be discussed by the faculty following your performance. The decision of the faculty will be conveyed to you through the Instrumental Studies Coordinator.

<u>Student Instructions</u>: Sign up for an appropriate jury time. Complete a standard jury form, and bring three copies of the completed form with you to instrumental juries. This jury examination will also serve as an upperclassman Advancement.
