ASBURY UNIVERSITY DEPARTMENT OF MUSIC Upperclassman Voice Study Advancement Request

Voice students desiring to enter the VOC-411 level of private lessons typically have completed at least 4 semesters of private study as a vocal music major. (Exceptions for students who have entered the degree late but have equivalent voice lesson experience will be handled individually.) Students may request advancement from the vocal faculty at the jury exam completing the 4th semester or as part of an RCT 280 evaluation, but students may not begin the 400-level of vocal study until the advancement request is approved.

Students should be prepared to demonstrate requirements equivalent to the Sophmore-Level NATS Student Audition requirements when they make an Advancement Request:

- 1. At least two foreign-language art songs sung in the original languages.¹
- 2. An aria (opera/oratorio/cantata/mass) appropriate for the voice. (Arias such as those from 28 Italian Songs & Arias will not meet this requirement.)
- 3. At least one 20th-century art song by an American, Canadian, or British composer.

Student Instructions: Complete not only (1) your jury form but also (2) this form and (3) a complete repertoire list of <u>all</u> vocal literature studied at the collegiate level, including voice study at other universities. Repertoire list is to be organized by language (English, French, German, Italian, etc.) with complete titles, names of larger works from which songs or arias are taken, complete composer names with birth-death years and the date or semester in which each piece was studied. (Attach 1 copy of this form and 1 copy of the repertoire list to the vocal jury form.)
