SATISFYING THE FOUNDATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Students meeting any foundational requirements with major courses, or by waivers of any kind, must still meet the total credit hours required to graduate with a degree. **Students with waivers of any foundational requirements must still meet the minimum credits required for graduation (60 for Associate's, and 124 for Bachelor's degree).**

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
