Majors in Art and Art Education are offered for students who want to consider a career in any number of visual art and art-related fields, through the study and practice of Art. The Art Grades P–12 Major includes a battery of courses provided by the School of Education, which is approved and accredited by the Kentucky Education Professional Standards Board and accredited by the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP). This degree adequately prepares the student for teacher certification in Kentucky.

To graduate must complete all major requirements, foundational requirements, and additional electives needed for 124 hour minimum degree requirement. This program may require more than 124 credits for a degree due to specific requirements.
