The program builds on The Salvation Army student's College of Officer Training degree, Associate of Applied Science, and is delivered to cohorts of Army students over a five year cycle.

To graduate must complete all major requirements, foundational requirements, and additional electives needed for 124 hour minimum degree requirement.
