Open only to select students who have completed the Salvation Army College of Officer Training degree, this APS program is delivered by Asbury faculty through a combination of online courses and face-to-face intensive courses (some intensives taught at the Wilmore campus and others at The Salvation Army, New York headquarters). The program builds on The Salvation Army student's College of Officer Training degree, Associate of Applied Science, and is delivered to cohorts of Army students over a five year cycle.

To graduate must complete all major requirements, foundational requirements, and additional electives needed for 124 hour minimum degree requirement.
