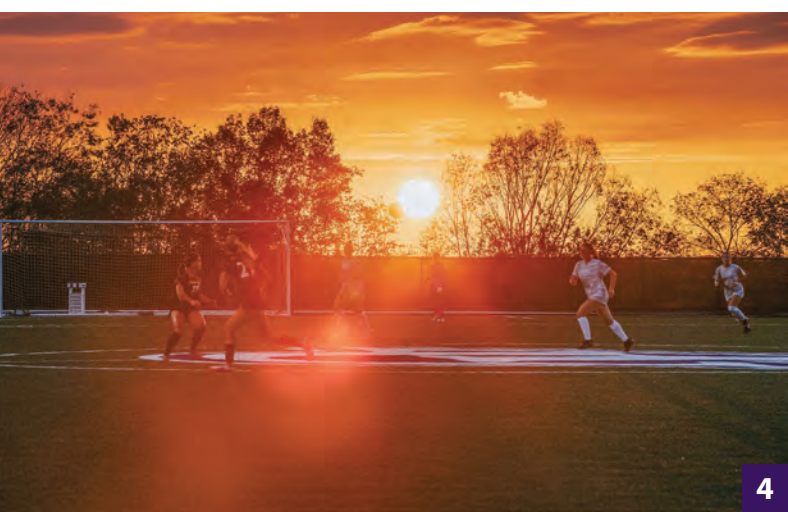

Sustainable growth for a flourishing future

Like other schools, for Asbury to flourish in the future as a robust Christian university, we need consistent and sustainable growth from academic offerings and programs, auxiliary services, and endowed assets.

We must effectively communicate the value of what we are offering. For colleges and universities, this has been a growing challenge. Broadly speaking, higher education's perceived purpose often falls within two camps. The first camp says it exists to foster the economic potential of students and enhance their market relevance ("utility model"). The second camp says it exists for personal fulfillment and the pursuit of happiness ("utopia model").

I think this is a limited characterization of higher education's value — and especially Christian higher education.

This summer at Reunion, I shared an illustration given by the late American pastor and author A.W. Tozer, where he describes three men walking through a forest: a poet, a naturalist, and a lumberjack. Each man, based upon his discipline, views the attributes of the forest in far different ways.

The poet sees metaphor. The tall and mighty trees are like great monarchs presiding over the kingdom of the forest. The naturalist sees nuance, a smaller and more detailed world. He delights in birdsong, can discern the threats an untrained eye could not, and understands the interdependence of the forest ecosystem. Finally, the lumberjack sees economic value and potentiality. His world involves seeing the forest for its lumber, its value, and how its raw state can be transformed into valuable goods.

Though Tozer had a different purpose in mind, I find his illustration helpfully analogous to how we think about education and the various dimensions of Asbury's value.

One dimension is "philo sophia" — the love of wisdom for its own sake. Expanding our horizons, making connections between the disciplines, broadening our imagination and understanding, and cultivating the norms of truth seeking.

Another is character development, a robust moral vision for life, and the habituated practices that shape our desires and our affix our trajectory unto the good life.

Another dimension of our work at Asbury is to enlarge a student's heart for the things of God and to be transformed by the renewing of their mind, "so that [they] may discern what is the will of God — what is good and acceptable and perfect." (Romans 12:2 NRSV).

Another is community and belonging — maturing from kindness and welcoming to deeper forms of attachment: responsibility, obligation and commitment.

Another dimension is maturation and preparation. Apprehending and refining skills necessary to navigate a dynamic future marketplace and add value to various professional spheres.

Finally, there is the dimension of economic investment. College graduates consistently experience far greater earning capacity throughout their lifetimes than non-college graduates.

Just as we would not want to reduce the forest to any one dimension (poetic, biological, or economic), we would not want to make education mono-dimensional. This is especially true of education at Asbury University, "A Christian Liberal Arts University in the Wesleyan-Holiness Tradition."

This is the value we offer. It is broad. It is deep. It is multi-dimensional. And it is focused on the next generation of Christ-followers. Our future growth and sustainability will be intimately tied to continually and comprehensively communicating and providing the fullness of Asbury's value.

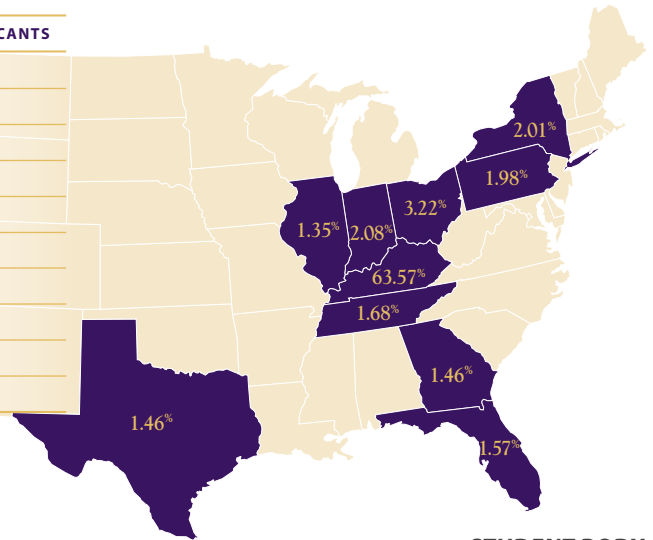

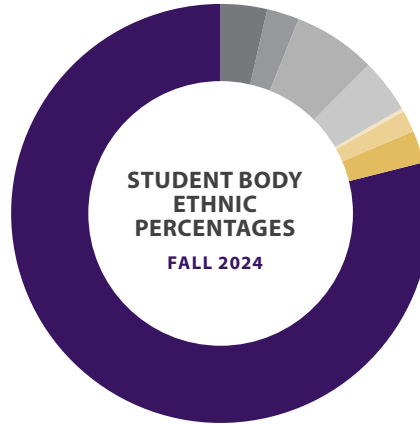

TOP 10 STATES BY APPLICATION IN 2024

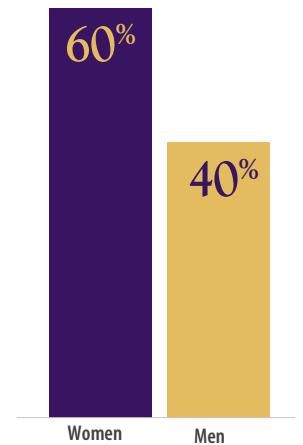

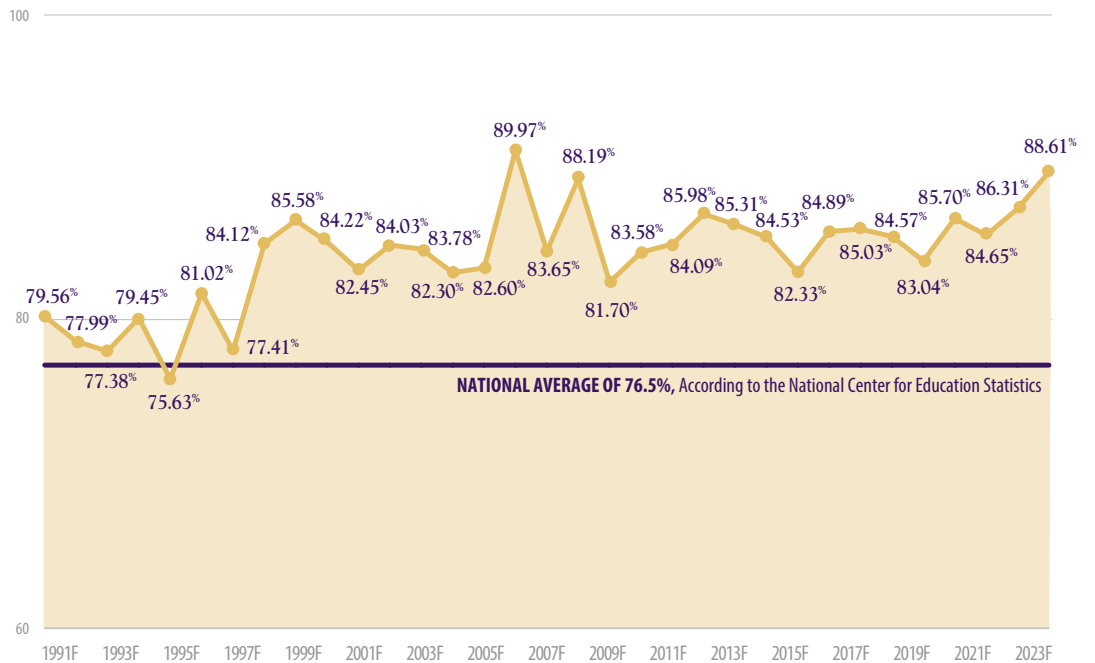

Asbury Celebrates Highest Enrollment in University History

The University celebrates 2024 as the highest enrollment in Asbury's 134-year history with a total enrollment headcount of 2,086. This exceeds the University record of 1,956 from Fall 2017. Here are some other record-breaking statistics this year:

A LOOK AT THE THIRD FACET OF ASBURY'S THREE-YEAR STRATEGIC FOCUS

Sustainable growth is critical for a university the size of Asbury. Growing sustainably — at a healthy and consistent pace that is manageable by the university's infrastructure and personnel — is critical to a flourishing future of Asbury students, faculty and staff alike. Achieving this goal is the third piece of President Dr. Kevin Brown's three-year Strategic Focus for Asbury University, along with stewardship and cultural climate.

"One uniform attribute of Asbury's leadership is a sincere and enthusiastic belief in the mission, vision, and value of the institution," said Brown. "While the methods and modalities by which that mission is fulfilled over time will change — the mission does not change. Thus, sustainability is very important to our leadership. This is

achieved by giving a realistic consideration to what Asbury does really well; continuing to maintain those practices, standards, and attributes that create excellence and value; and communicating the attractiveness of that value to future students and core constituents."

Sustainable growth encompasses consistent and sustainable revenue generation from academic offerings and programs, auxiliary services, and endowed assets. It requires thoughtful appraisals of Asbury's core competencies and how they can be leveraged, how academic offerings are relevant to student and employer demand, and a nimble business model that fosters growth and innovation with entrepreneurial and flexible programming.

"For Asbury to continue to flourish in the future, this means maintaining focus on those areas within our realm of competence, such as rigorous intellectual preparation

and spiritually formative transformation among our students,” Brown said. “We want to be able to offer multi-dimensional value. In other words, while we are engaged in the intellectual training, skill development, and market preparation of our students, we are equally committed to their distinctly Christian moral and spiritual formation.”

ENROLLMENT GROWTH MILESTONES REACHED

Asbury has reason to celebrate. Since 2023, the student headcount and net tuition revenue are on the rise. In September, Asbury celebrated the highest enrollment in its 134-year history with a total enrollment headcount of 2,086 across its traditional undergraduate, online undergraduate, graduate and high school dual enrollment programs. This exceeds Asbury’s record of 1,956 from Fall 2017 and meets a longstanding goal of 2,000 students.

“We are thrilled with the growth across all our programs. Students desiring what Asbury offers is a testament to the dedication of our faculty and staff in serving Generation Z through Christian higher education,” said Jennifer McChord, Vice President for Enrollment & Marketing. “We are grateful to those who laid the groundwork before us, enabling us to achieve sustainable growth at Asbury today. Our Christ-centered community and diverse academic programs continue to attract and retain students across all areas of study. At Asbury, students find a true sense of belonging, where they are nurtured, mentored, disciplined, and equipped to fulfill God’s calling in their lives, preparing them to make a distinctive impact in the marketplace.”

To continue this trajectory, Asbury will work toward more seamless student acquisition and will continually seek to identify, evaluate and launch new market sensitive programs with the assistance of real time data and input from each academic school under the guidance of each dean.

Additionally, Asbury is a tuition driven institution — with 88 percent of revenues coming from enrollment. While maintaining the growth in the traditional undergraduate program, another key focus area of available, sustainable enrollment growth is in the nontraditional programs, including students seeking bachelor’s and master’s degrees online.

GROWTH THROUGH STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL INDEPENDENCE

Keeping this education affordable with financial support from donors, grants and organizations is critical to growth. This includes endowed scholarships which support the university in perpetuity regardless of political and cultural changes. Funding in these areas helps fulfill the mission of sustainable growth, creating affordability for all students in a growing student body.

“We are excited about the growing number of partners that are investing in our students and in Asbury’s future,” said Vice President for Institutional Advancement & Strategic Partnerships Dr. Mark Troyer. “More endowed scholarships have been created in the last decade than any other time in our history. Sustainable growth means equipping the University to make an impact for a very long time.”

In the last four years, Asbury has received almost \$14 million in charitable gifts for both endowed and non-endowed scholarships. Currently 100 percent of traditional undergraduate students receive financial aid or scholarships, allowing Asbury to compete nationally for exceptional students, thereby strengthening the institution through the quality, diversity and accomplishments of our student body.

As leadership evaluates the uncertain political and legislative climate and plans for the future, Asbury seeks to establish an expanded foundation of available scholarship dollars. Despite Asbury’s diligence in keeping the combined cost of tuition, housing, meal plans and fees as low as possible, the cost to educate students continues to rise.

Currently, close to 38 percent of undergraduate students are Federal Pell grant eligible, more than nine percent of the incoming class are first generation college students, and more than 50 percent are from Kentucky, the nation’s fifth poorest state. Further, the average financial gap of a student “with need” is more than \$25,000.* This makes sustainable scholarship endowments crucial to the mission of Asbury.

“Two-thirds of our current endowment is designated to some form of student scholarship,” Troyer said. “This creates a more sustainably funded future for students and the University alike that’s less constrained by challenging market and cultural conditions. As our team works to meet the needs of the current student body, we continually explore ways to make our student aid sustainable and permanent as the University looks to the future. God consistently surprises us with new friends and the generosity of longtime supporters. Asbury has an advantage in the future due to our strong alumni and donor base.”

EYE ON THE FUTURE

Navigating cultural challenges, financial responsibilities, marketability and remaining deeply rooted in Asbury’s spiritual heritage, leadership is compelled to seek a sustainable future to ensure Asbury can continue its Kingdom work for years to come. The University must remain fiscally secure in order to live out its mission of advancing the cause of Christ around the world with academic excellence and spiritual depth and vitality.

“Sustainability relates to the work we do in the present with an eye toward the future,” Brown said. “We want to make decisions today that will create a pathway to a flourishing future for Asburians who are not yet even born. This is very similar to the service mentality we hope to exhibit and encourage in our students. Our best life is the ‘self-emptying’ community life lived for others and that includes those around us now. This ‘best life’ also includes those who are to come in the future. On our best day, we hope to plant seeds whose fruit will bless others both far and wide.”

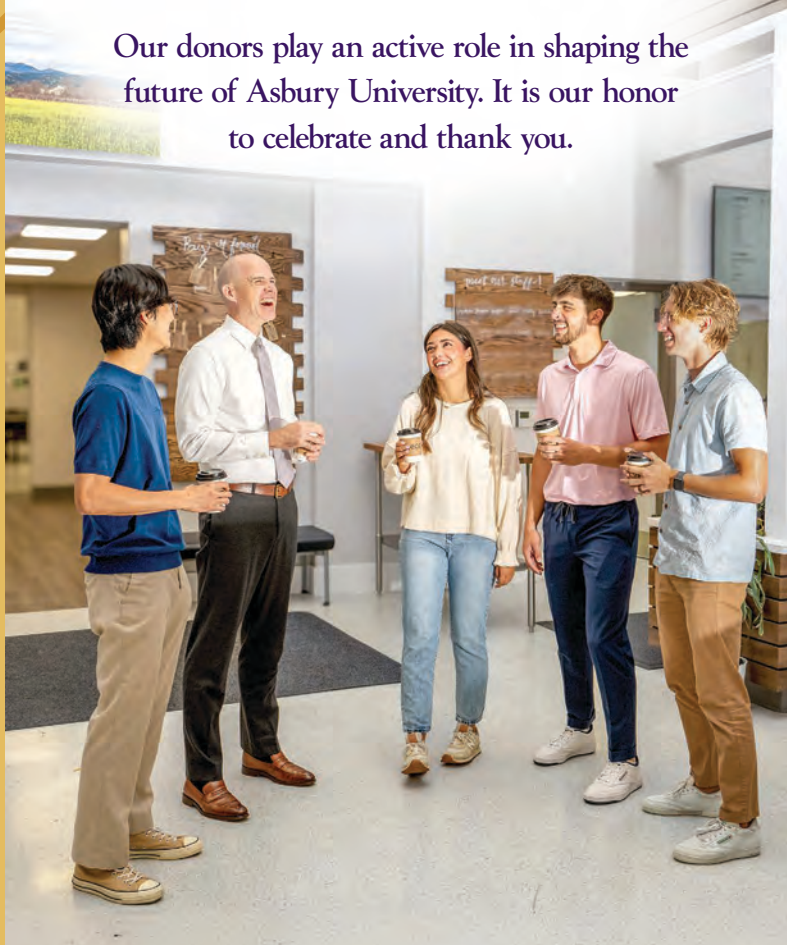

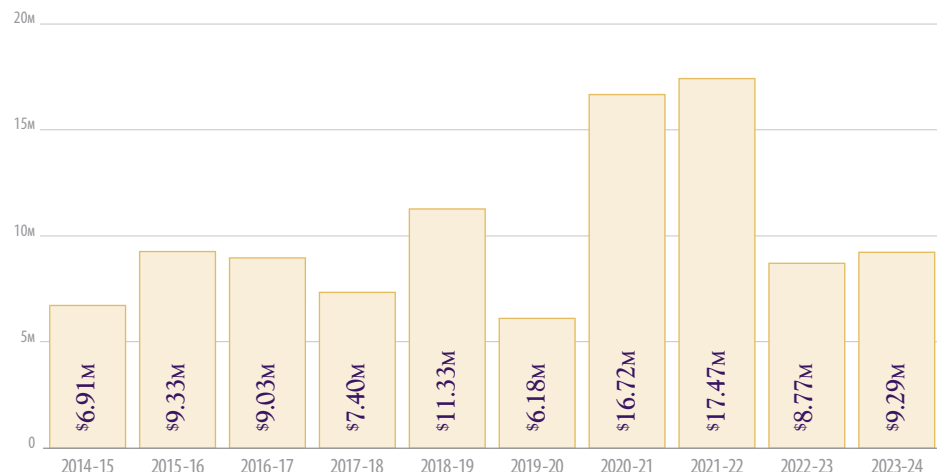

Denham-Blythe Construction Co. began the second and final phase of Asbury's Outdoor Venue project this summer following D.W. Wilburn's successful completion of Phase I in August 2023. This final construction phase includes the additions of a press box, meeting rooms, public restrooms, locker rooms and a training room. Landscaping enhancements, expanded parking facilities, and advanced media and technology installations, including a video scoreboard, are also planned.

The Outdoor Venue is a multi-use facility designed to enrich campus life, impact the student formational experience, host TeamAU athletics events, and grow athletics as a platform to glorify God.

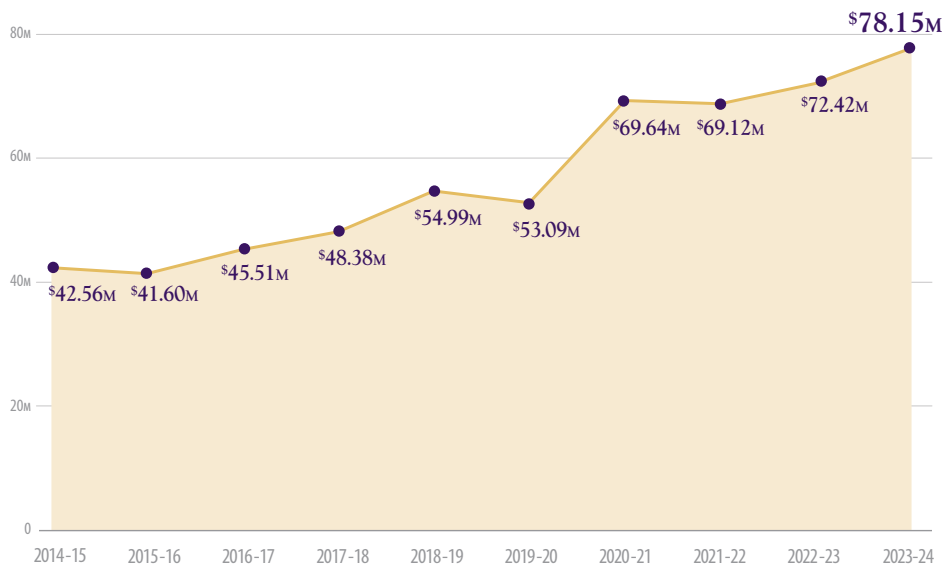

A Timeline of Asbury University's Sustainable Growth

1885 – 1884

1890

First announcement of the Kentucky Holiness School located in Wilmore, Ky.



1947-1948

More than 30% of the student body were war veterans.

1950

Asbury experienced God's presence in a mighty way during another revival.



1946

The young College accepted 700 students for fall and turned down 500 "for lack of room."

1950-60

Campus construction and expansion increased to meet the needs of Asbury's growing enrollment (Johnson Cafeteria, Trustees Men's Dorm, McCreless Center for Fine Art)

1917

The United States entered World War I

1907

A revival spread across the Asbury and the surrounding areas. E. Stanley Jones said that this revival liberated him from a sense of superiority, which prepared him for future work as a missionary, opening his eyes to the Holy Spirit, and leading directly to his calling to the mission field.

1939

Asbury's Campus in 1939, when Germany invaded Poland, marking the beginning of World War II.



1964

The "Singing Ambassadors," a mixed traveling choral group, was formed by Prof. Jack Rains '41.

1924

Fire broke out in Mary Crawford Hall, engulfing two residence halls, half the new dining hall, a new power plant, and 11 private residences. The girl's new building was ready for occupancy by fall, establishing two major wings, named for Lizzie Glide and Mary Crawford.



1970

God's power comes in response to prayer and confession at the revival that poured out over campus and spread around the world.



1928

Henry Clay Morrison and John Wesley Hughes broke ground for Hughes Auditorium.



1984

The broadcast program rapidly grew under Dr. Jim Owens '79 to prepare people in "Christian media." Students began working with the Olympics in Los Angeles.

1985– 2024

1987

Endowment crosses \$10 million. Pictured from 1987 is the Old Tabernacle at the Wilmore Campgrounds. Students often used it for worship, and it also was a venue for the Ichthus Music Festival.



1990

Asbury hosted a Centennial Celebration, beginning the tradition of a summer Reunion event.



1997

A proposal to establish an equine program at the University was accepted.

2001

Kinlaw Library opened to students, marking a significant upgrade for Asbury's educational resources.



2007

Dr. Sandra C. Gray becomes Asbury's first female president, serving for 12 years.



2010

The Miller Center for Communication Arts was built to provide a more realistic atmosphere for students planning to work in communication industries.

2009

Asbury becomes a University.

2004

A \$1 million gift established the Asbury Initiative for Servant Leadership, encouraging internships for students to volunteer around the world.

2012

Asbury places more emphasis on a liberal arts education, adding the required Liberal Arts Seminar for students.

2014

Asbury reaches its high enrollment of 1,857.

"U.S. News and World Report" ranked Asbury as "Number One Regional College (South)" in the United States.

2023

More than 50,000 people flooded Asbury and Wilmore to experience the power of an outpouring of God's Holy Spirit. Now referred to as the Outpouring, it lasted for 16 days, culminating with the National Collegiate Day of Prayer.

2022

The Walt and Rowena Shaw Collaborative Learning Center opened to students.



2017

Endowment crosses \$50 million.

2018

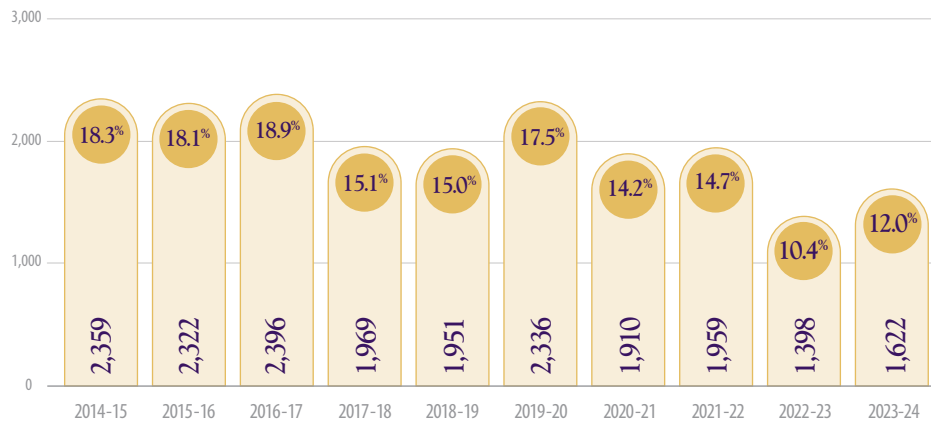

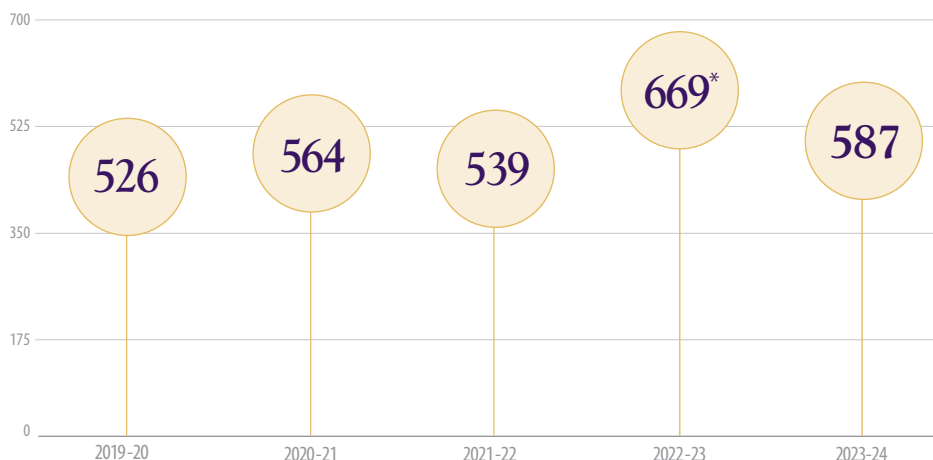

Bridging Generations of Faith

The Kyriakidis family honors Greek heritage by establishing the Kairos Fund to support students' spiritual growth

Elizabeth "Betty" Butler '65 Kyriakidis is the daughter of Salvation Army officers. When she was a child, her parents hosted an Asbury musical quartet on spring break in their corps. This experience inspired a desire for their own children to attend a school like Asbury, where they could grow in their Christian faith. The Butler children — **John '64, LeRoy '64, and Betty '65** — all attended Asbury.

While at Asbury, Betty began a three-generation tradition of not only attending the University but also living in the Glide-Crawford residence hall. Little did she know her daughter, **Kimberly "Kim" Kyriakidis '92 George Race**, would also choose Asbury and Glide-Crawford, as would Kim's daughter, **Alexandria "Alex" George '19 Lemons**. Alex not only lived in Glide-Crawford but also served as a resident assistant and assistant resident director during her time at Asbury. Kim's son, Christopher George, also attended Asbury.



"Asbury means so much to each of us," Kim said. "It's difficult to put it into words. It is certainly where we each found our lifelong friends."

One of Kim's Asbury roommates, **Jessica Bookout '92 Dunnaway**, and her husband, **Darin '89**, serve as Alex's godparents. Additionally, one of Alex's Asbury friends, **Robin Gerike '19 Cooney**, and her husband, **Drew '19**, have agreed to be godparents to Alex and her husband Bryson's baby, expected in January 2025.

Each family member credits Asbury for solid spiritual foundations that even influence their family's Greek restaurant, The Acropolis, in Chattanooga, Tenn.

"I learned how important it is to develop healthy spiritual habits," Betty said. "This is what helps me to continue my spiritual growth and share my faith with others at the restaurant."

The Kyriakidis family has run The Acropolis for nearly 30 years. Before that, they owned restaurants in East Ridge, Tenn.; Asbury Park, N.J.; and Neptune, N.J. It was through the restaurant business that Betty met her husband, Teddy, a Greek immigrant who often employed Asbury students during the summers in Asbury Park.

The Acropolis remains the cornerstone of Betty's ministry, and she frequently shares stories about Asbury and serves alumni who stop to eat there while traveling through Chattanooga, visiting with Betty, Kim, and Alex. The restaurant has hosted three Asbury presidents, dozens of staff and faculty members, and even entire Asbury sports teams. Betty often reflects on how many people she meets who have a connection to Asbury — just as her family does to this day.

Kim and Alex joined Betty for her 50th reunion, and the entire family attends every reunion they can. Kim has even served on the Alumni Board. They have also been long-time donors, hoping that today's students will continue growing closer to the Lord and learn to live out their faith in a challenging world.

Recently, they came together to discuss how to make a greater impact with their gifts. They agreed they wanted Asbury to continue to have the resources it needs to support the spiritual growth of its students, including offering the Set Apart retreats.

With a desire to honor their Greek heritage and keep the focus off the family name, they established the Kairos Fund. "Kairos" is Greek and means "a significant or critical time."

"Each of us has had a Kairos moment in our faith journey at Asbury," Kim said. "It is our heart's desire that other students may have a Kairos moment on a Set Apart retreat."

Caleb Griffin '14 is the Assistant Director of VFL Films for University of Tennessee Athletics. He covered the baseball team's historic 2022 season, including its College World Series win, and embraces the life of traveling and being on a team, admitting that it "still feels surreal." At Asbury, he played soccer, worked as an Admissions Ambassador, worked at the 2014 Sochi Winter Olympics, served with Residential Life and acted in his sophomore musical. Majoring in Media Communication combined his love of teamwork, athletics, and camera operation.

"I think of those years as unmatched in rich connection — to the biblical community, teammates, professors and to the Lord," Griffin said. "Besides my hometown where I grew up, Asbury is the only place that has truly felt like home."

What Griffin experienced in college solidified his dream of combining media production, traveling and sports into a career and a calling. He said God opened doors and eventually brought Griffin to the Houston Astros Ballpark Entertainment Crew, where he freelanced when the Astros won the American League in 2019 and 2021, and the World Series in 2022. Then, he worked full-time as a video producer at Texas A&M Athletics until the summer of 2023.

"I could not have imagined the career journey He's taken me on over the last ten years," Griffin said. "But He's been faithful to guide me each step with some really incredible experiences along the way."

Tim Johnston '08 works as the Director of Creative Content for the Texas Rangers, a professional baseball team. He has been with the team for six years and has won five Emmys for his media work there. He oversees content creation largely for TV and radio advertising, produces two podcasts, and creates social media videos and onset direction. At Asbury, Johnston double majored in Spanish and Media Communications.

While at Asbury he also assisted in broadcasting basketball, filmed the first-ever Asbury sitcom, and worked at the 2008 Olympics in Beijing, China. He credits the University for giving him practical experience that not many other students his age understood.

"Regarding the future, I'll follow where God guides me," he said. "He hasn't steered me wrong yet, and certainly, I am happy and honored to be here with the Rangers. It's a dream realized for a team I grew up cheering for and it's a sweet reward."

Additionally, we continue to have various groups visit Asbury from around the world to spend time in Hughes or attend a Chapel service to pray for continued revival, experience the space and hear stories about the Outpouring and its continued impact.

Pastor-in-Residence Rev. Zach Meerkreebs shares how the Outpouring is still impacting his experience in ministry.

“Whatever we might call what occurred on our beloved campus, it has definitely served as an envisioning wake-up call to the church,” he said. “There have been unbelievable encounters between Jesus and students at many large state schools. Testimonies of the Outpouring filled conversations at the monumental Lausanne Conference. Churches, conferences, and communities of leaders are still hungry to glean from what we experienced and have been learning from God meeting us in such a sweet and unique way in Hughes Auditorium. I continue to think that in a month or two it will be all done, but no, it seems like the momentum of what God is doing around the world is only growing and our humbled “two spies” (Numbers 13 and 14) testimony gets to encourage many along the way. 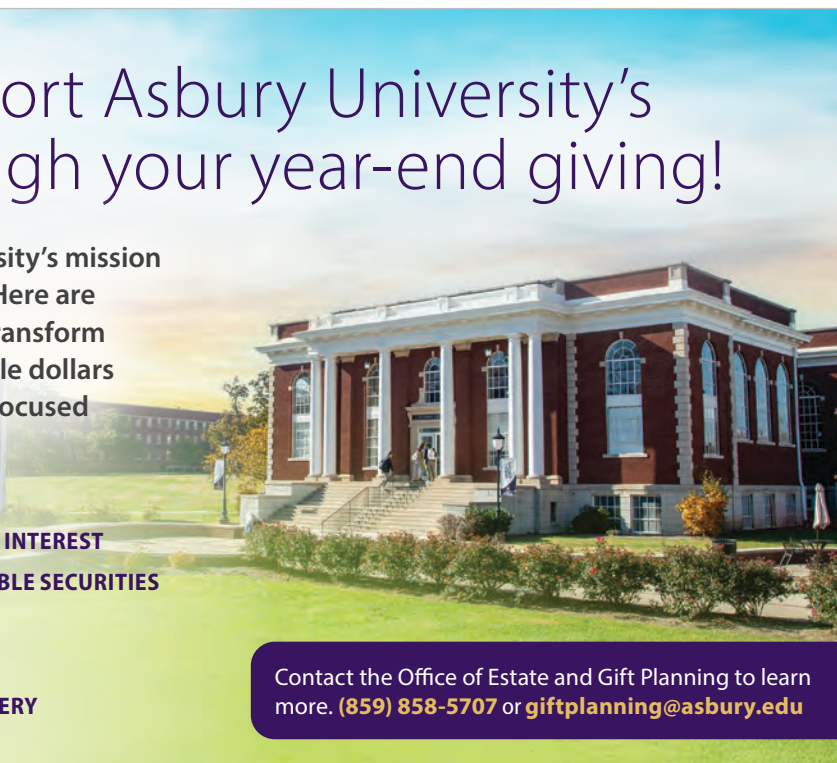

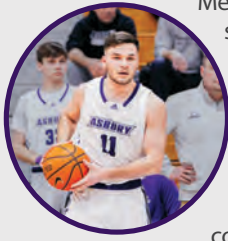

It was incredible to be part of such a huge project that would be seen all over the world, and I found myself sharing in the emotions of the athletes and their families."

ASBURY BECOMES FIRST SCHOOL IN U.S. TO RECEIVE ARRI CERTIFICATION



In July, Asbury University received recognition as the nation's only ARRI Certified Film School, joining the ranks of a select few other institutions

around the world. According to ARRI's website, "The ARRI Certified Film School Program is an opportunity for

film schools to benefit from ARRI Academy's education resources for a full year and to pass those benefits on to their students."

Approximately 80 percent of top grossing films are shot on ARRI cameras, and close to 65% of all award-winning films at the Academy Awards, Cannes Film Festival and Sundance Film Festival are shot on ARRI cameras.

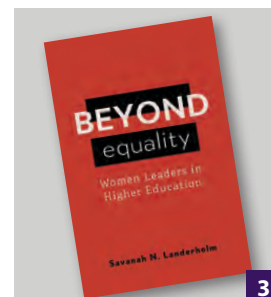
